

## Facility Expansion We're Proud of What We've Accomplished

Drawing from the organizational motto to "lending a hand up to others," Community Outreach in Action, Inc. has found that the scale of poverty is almost endless.

But the organization has also discovered an unwavering willingness to donate food supplies for those who need it most. Food donations stream into the facility, which are then redistributed to the more than 1,200 low-income residents in south metro Atlanta monthly. All total, more than 12 truckloads of products enter and then leave our facility every month.

As a result, we have outgrown our current location and we are planning a major expansion with the opening of our client choice grocery store in 2022. For the past year, Community Outreach in Action has solicited donations privately for

this project — now it's coming to fruition.

### Why I Give

We have people in our community who have to decide between different basic needs. There are people out there who need help and the food pantry is there to support them. With this new expansion, I'm hopeful to be able to help even more people who need assistance.
